### **Awards & Trophy Pickup**

- Three judges per ring; Head Referee makes final decisions & Mark the wristbands
- Match Winners: 4 TO A DIVISION—USE THE BYE SYSTEM ON THE RING TABLE TO SEE WHO FIGHTS
- 1st Place Must win the match//• 2nd, 3rd, and 4th Places Awarded accordingly
